

Reminder to Property Owners and Guests to Carry Valid Facility Access Cards When Using GH-CP Properties and Facilities

On **August 1, 2017** as stated in our rules, at least one person in any group of users at any Sanitary District property or facility must carry a valid Facility Access Card and vouch for the others in their group. The requirement to carry the Facility Access Card and vouch for others in your group applies not only at the pool, but to any Sanitary District facility and property. **This includes the beaches and the boat ramps.**

In response to calls from concerned residents, the Sheriff's Department "escorted" several people off the main Cabin Point Beach who had camped out for the night. These people were not property owners in the community and they were not guests of property owners. Our facilities and the beaches are for the exclusive use of property owners and their guests. They are not open to the public. The Sheriff's Department is patrolling all community properties, including the beaches, to enforce rules and maintain a safe environment. Presenting your access card will enable officers to focus their attention on potential trespassers.

Please be sure that **at least one person in the group is carrying a valid Facility Access Card** and can vouch for all others in the group. Property owners and their guests are always welcome to use the beach areas for night fishing, but please remember that overnight camping on the beaches and open fires are not permitted.
